

## Nine Signs Community Check-up

We need eyes to see and ears to hear what is broken in our communities and the ways God is already working to restore and heal it. Use this community check-up to better see your community and what the Spirit is already doing. Be sure to invite other neighbors into your check-up, ask what they can see!

For each Sign write an how shalom has been broken and an asset God has given the community to respond. In the example below, shalom is broken in Lifelong Education because the local school is under-funded and struggling to help kids. The **assets**<sup>\*</sup> available to bring shalom include people, community space, and community organizations. The final column helps you assess your own interest, skills, and capacity to invest in that particular Sign. Gauging your interest will help you decide where focus your energy.

\*Assets are people, skills, resources, strengths, organizations, and more within a community that promote shalom. Some examples include street lights, access to council members, parks, corner stores where folks gather, or community information hubs (be they people or posterboards!).
